**“WHEN THE RED, RED ROBIN”**

OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK      Sides face, grand square  
When the red, red, robin comes a bob, bob, bobbin' along  
Along  
There'll be no more sobbin' when he comes throbbin'  
His old sweet song      (Circle left)  
Wake up, wake up, you sleepy head  
Get up, get up, get out of bed  
Allemande left that corner then you promenade home  
Live, love, laugh and be happy

FIGURE

Head two couples promenade 'bout halfway around you know  
And a right & left thru and then  
A square thru to 4, go walkin' the floor  
Split your sides round one, make a line, go up and down  
Touch 1/4, boys run and your corner swing now  
Hey let's promenade that ring  
When the red, red robin starts bob, bob, bobbin'  
Along

CLOSER

Four Boys Promenade one time round that old ring  
Come on you'd better Swing  
Oh, join hands Circle go moving round the ring and then  
Left Allemande and you Weave  
Oh, I'm just a kid again doing what I did again  
Ah, singing a song
